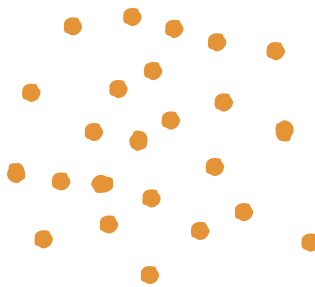

Collaborative Consultation Visits

\$605 per visit (2 hours)

An experienced speech pathologist or occupational therapist can visit your facility to offer in-class support and consultation, targeted around supporting a particular child or children in the group (with parent consent). The service helps everyone work together to solve challenges and build educator confidence in the setting where the child learns best. The therapist will spend 2 hours in the centre, observe the group, watch the child with their routine and peers, and talk with educators about current supports and any extra skill-building needed.

This service can help when a child has limited verbal skills or uses an AAC device, when a child is struggling with transitions, or when challenging behaviours are appearing in the Kindy environment.

During the visit, the therapist will share strategies, practical ideas and helpful tools/resources. When possible, they will model these in real time so educators can try them with confidence e.g. AAC training.

An added fee applies for larger personalised resources. Fees also cover planning, preparation and local travel.



Screening Assessment Services

\$605 per visit/discipline

A two-hour visit from our speech or occupational therapist includes observing group play, speaking with educators, and screening children with suspected delays or higher needs. Educators select children to be referred for screening, and consent forms are provided for families. Each screened child receives a written summary of results and recommendations. A summary can also be provided to the centre regarding observations and strategies recommended for the class group.

What does a screening assessment include?

Fees include the visit, travel, and report preparation. Screenings will cover pre-prep areas of articulation, understanding and use of language, and early literacy for speech pathology, or for occupational therapy, key developmental skills such as emotional regulation, self-care, motor skills, social skills or sensory concerns.

1. Little Music Makers - Music Therapy Class Sessions

- Our Registered Music Therapist (RMT) leads a fun and engaging group that supports key prep-readiness skills such as engagement, listening, smooth transitions, social play and confidence.
- Educators learn simple songs for assisting with routines and tricky transitions, movement and instrument activities, and a clear understanding of how music supports learning and social growth.
- Available weekly or fortnightly, can be booked as 1x45 minute group or 2x30 minute groups per visit, minimum booking of 4 visits

2. Prep for Prep - Kindy class 8-week program

- Combined Speech Pathology and Occupational Therapy designed program, run by a Speech Pathologist
- Our Prep for Prep 8 week school readiness program helps children feel confident and ready for their first year of school.
- These sessions focus on developing essential skills such as listening, language, phonics, early writing, literacy, and social interaction.
- Each session is hand-on, has a consistent routine, and a book theme.
